Dear C.A.E.P. Member:

The final programme for our first annual scientific meeting is on its way to the printers. We wanted to include the preliminary programme for those not present at our last meeting in this mailing.

The meeting will be held at the scenic Bayshore Inn in Vancouver, B.C. on April 16 - 18. There will be an opportunity to do an A.C.L.S. course April 14 and 15. We have chosen a wide spectrum of speakers and topics but will make them practical and detailed especially with the use of limited registration workshops in the afternoon.

Dr. Wayne Smith, Royal Victoria Hospital Montreal and Dr. Greg Powell, Foothills Hospital Calgary, are organizing scientific papers and round table discussions during the two long noon hour lunches. The emergency nurses group of B.C. are co-sponsoring the programme and we are expecting a significant enrollment of nurses from as far away as Ontario. It was done on the expectation that they could use the opportunity to discuss the advantages of also forming a national organization. To allow as many physicians as possible to attend we will limit the lower priced nursing registration.
