The Donation Physician Network supports, reinforces and expands regional networks of donation-focused physicians in offering organ donation as a standard component of end-of-life care. Members have access to mentors, experts and leading practices that would otherwise be unavailable to this specialized group of physicians, particularly those practicing in smaller hospitals or jurisdictions.
