

CPD Report

We are pleased to report the CAEP CPD had another strong performance during the 2021/22 Calendar year.

2021 saw the continuation of online CPD through our National Grand Rounds which are free to CAEP members and clinical webinars which are available freely on the CAEP website. CAEP also held its third leadership series (2nd one held virtually) in the Fall of 2021 and offered the Geriatric-EM course in April 2022 for the first time in a virtual setting.

CAEP's online CPD has been highly popular, especially throughout the pandemic. CAEP has offered 15 National Grand Rounds and 5 webinars from September 2021 – May 2022. These have been highly popular, both for the live event and the on-demand viewing. The Virtual Leadership Series (VLS) and Geriatric-EM course were full courses and will be offered again in Fall 2022.

In November 2021, CAEP reintroduced in-person courses; starting with AIME in Halifax. CAEP also offered 2 courses at Rural and Remote in Ottawa in April and 2 courses at the CAEP conference in Québec City. There has been a high demand for AIME throughout the pandemic and this has been reflected in the courses selling out.

The CPD Committee has been working on developing some new offerings that we hope to launch in the Fall. The first is the CAEP Women in EM CPD Series. This was put forward to the CPD Committee by the CAEP Women in EM Committee. This offering will have several modules and will be a mix of asynchronous and synchronous learning. We hope to open up registration shortly.

The next new offering is a Journal Club for rural physicians. CAEP will be partnering with BEEM to offer a journal club in conjunction with rural speakers. It will be a virtual journal club with an anticipated launch in the Fall of this year. If interested in participating as a speaker/presenter, please reach out to the CAEP Head Office.

Lastly, CAEP has been working on identifying a team to develop the CAEP Cast; CAEP's new podcast which should launch this Fall. Stay tuned for more information!
