

## Position: Patient and Community Representative, Antiracism and Anticolonialism Committee

Call for expressions of interest: Due November 18, 2022

**The Canadian Association of Emergency Physicians (CAEP) Antiracism and Anticolonialism Committee is seeking expressions of interest for patient and community member representatives on the committee executive.**

The CAEP Antiracism and Anticolonialism Committee was formed in response to the critical need for formal dialogue and action to address systemic racism in emergency medicine. Its mandate is to address racism and colonialism in emergency medicine in patient care, physician advancement, professional development, and education. It is also committed to providing advocacy, support, mentorship, and networking opportunities for Emergency Physicians who are Black, Indigenous and persons of colour, and allies.

The committee reports to the CAEP Board of Directors. CAEP is the national representative body for emergency medicine physicians in Canada.

The official committee work will be conducted in English.

No medical training background is required. Potential applicants are encouraged to reflect on the following selection criteria:

- Demonstrated ability to work in a team and maintain collaborative relationships
- Lived experience of racism or experience or expertise with anti-racism or anti-colonialism activities
- Community connections
- Demonstrated knowledge or experience with the emergency/acute care system (e.g., as a patient, caregiver advocate, family member, or other experience) is an asset.
- As a community member you will have the opportunity to help shape the mandate and priorities for the Antiracism and Anticolonialism committee.

The committee meets at minimum two times per year but may meet up to every two months depending on the status of current projects. Meetings are held virtually. An honoraria of \$200 per year will be provided in recognition of attendance and participation during at least 80% of the annual meetings. The term of appointment would be for 2 years.
