

CAEP is seeking proposals for the Fall 2014 National Grand Rounds (NGR). The NGR was an initiative that started out as COVID Town Halls that transformed over time into CAEP's NGR. We had a very successful line up throughout the Fall of 2020 and Spring of 2021 and are now seeking proposals/ideas for the upcoming year.

The NGR are accredited through both college streams by CAEP, and as such, a minimum of 25% interactivity is required. This usually comes in the form of live Q&A, however, we encourage presenters to incorporate polling and other interactivity features to enhance the audience's experience.

The NGR will be scheduled for one hour with the day of the week and timing of the event being consistent throughout the year. The committee is reviewing feedback on the timing of these events and will determine a set day/time for the GR based on the CPD needs assessment. Recordings will be made available to all CAEP members and CAEP is looking into certified self-learning credits under the College of Family Physicians.

The NGR are a CAEP member benefit and therefore free access to the GR will be restricted to CAEP members.* Non-CAEP members will be able to access the GR for a fee (priced per session).
